PROJECTS/SERIES

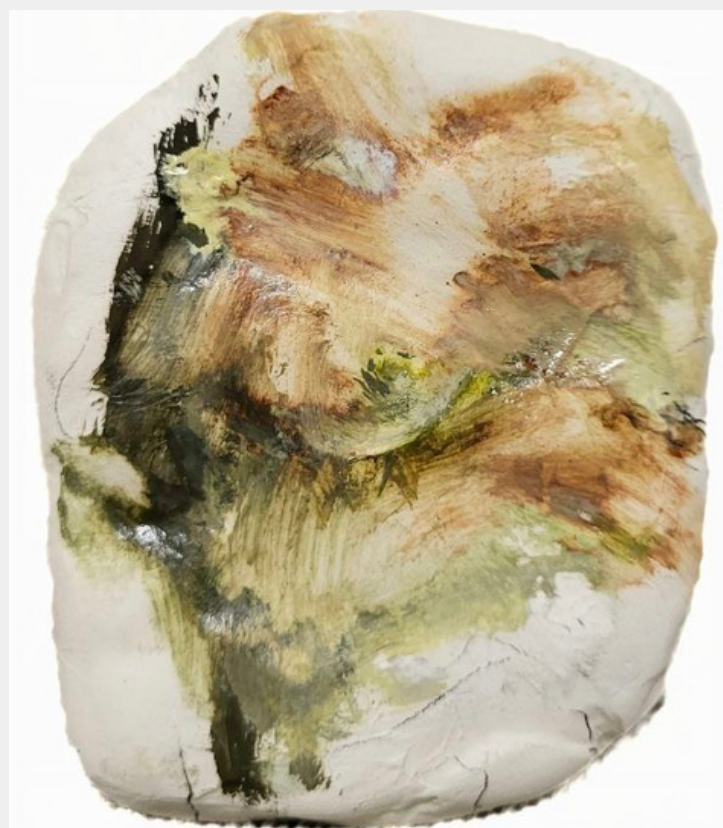

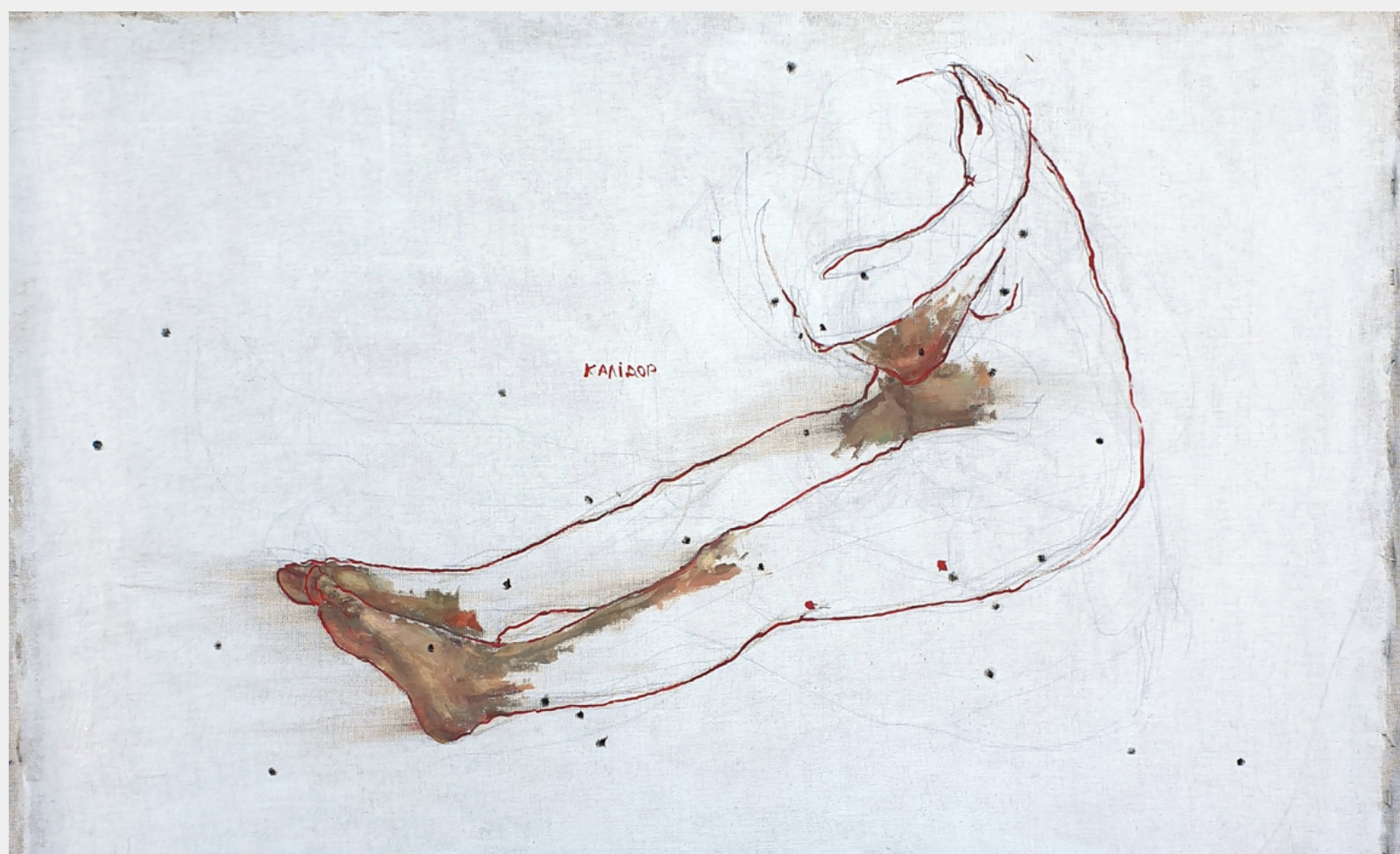

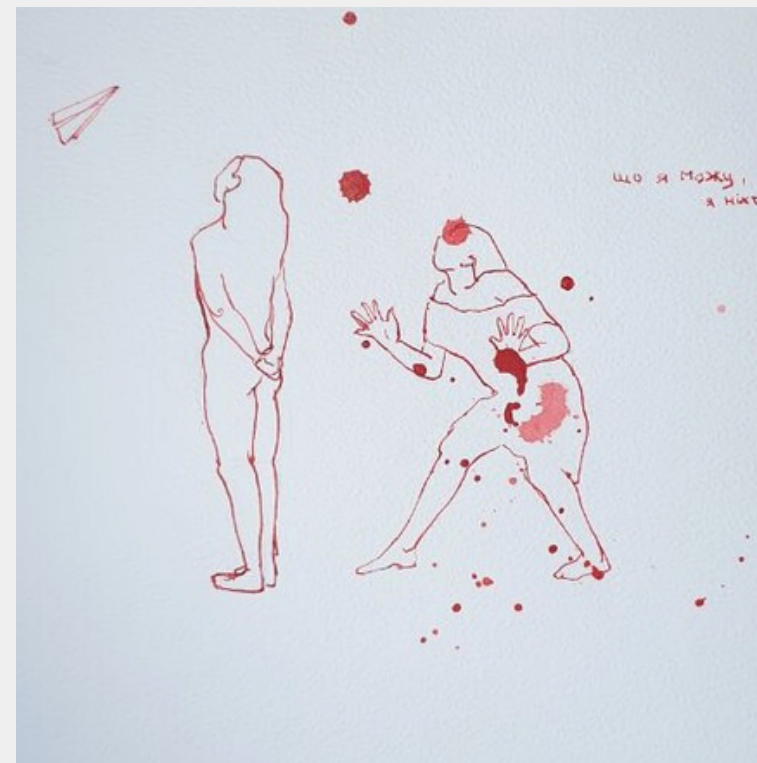
