

Olena Pryduvalova (born 1960) is a Ukrainian artist. She was born in Kyiv. She graduated from the T.G. Shevchenko Republican Art School in 1979 and the Kyiv State Institute of Arts in 1986, where she studied in the workshop of S. Podervyanskyi. She was awarded the first prize at the "Outstanding Women Artists of Ukraine" competition in 1998 and became a member of the National Union of Artists of Ukraine (NSHU) in 1999.

Olena Pryduvalova works in the fields of graphic art, painting, applied decorative art, and is engaged in the creation of motanka dolls.

She has participated in numerous group exhibitions in Ukraine and abroad and has held over 20 personal exhibitions in Ukraine, Canada, and the United States. Her works are housed in the National Museum "Kyiv Art Gallery," the Zaporizhzhia Regional Art Museum, the National Museum of Women in the Arts (Washington, D.C.), the Soros Center for Contemporary Art at NaUKMA, the University of Chicago collection, as well as in private collections in Ukraine, Poland, the USA, Canada, France, Germany, Spain, the UK, Scotland, Greece, Sweden, and Japan.
